

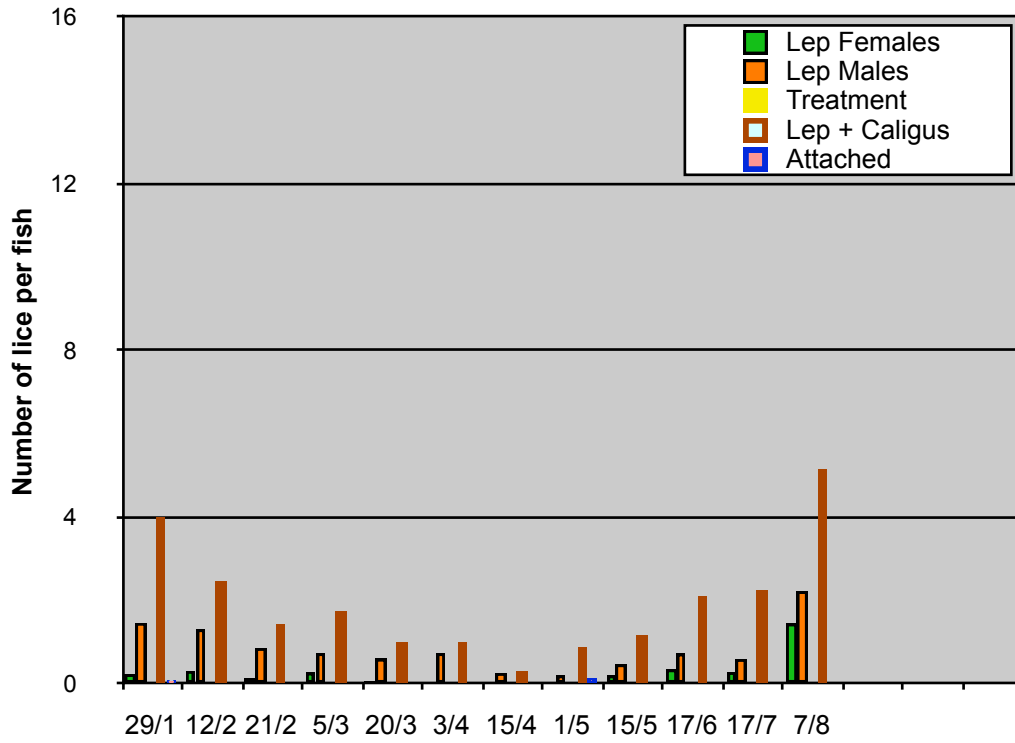
# Bioemitter Sealice Control Data 2008

2008 Sealice data from Muiracchmani Teo, Connemara, Eire, collected by Marine Institute, Galway the Eire Government monitoring body for sealice control.

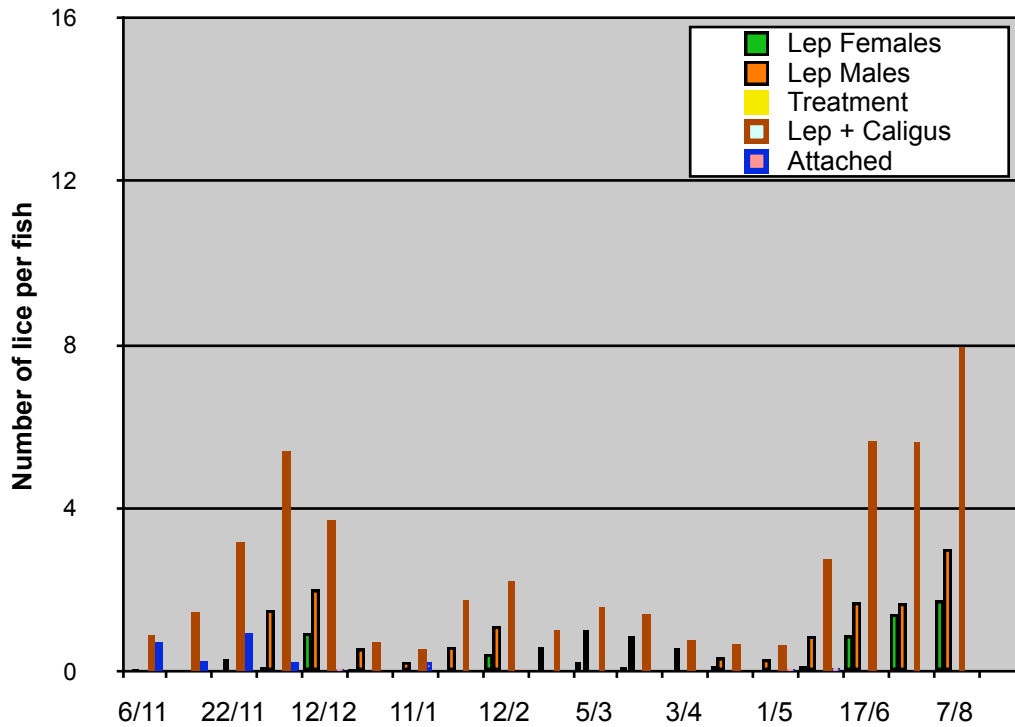
From the graphs it can be seen from over the period of monitoring the cages did not require any treatments. It had always been necessary to treat during this period in these locations before the advent of the Bioemitter systems.

It can also be seen that although blooms of sealice came onto the cages the Bioemitter system removed the infestations without any other intervention. The lice numbers were kept at an acceptably low level throughout the period.

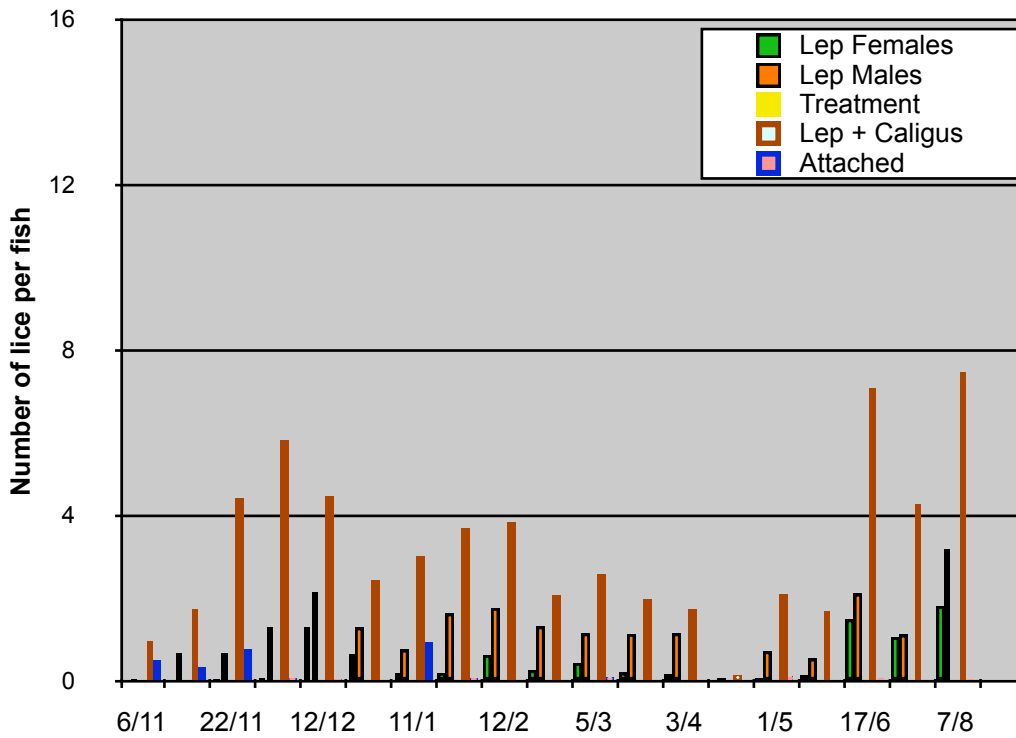

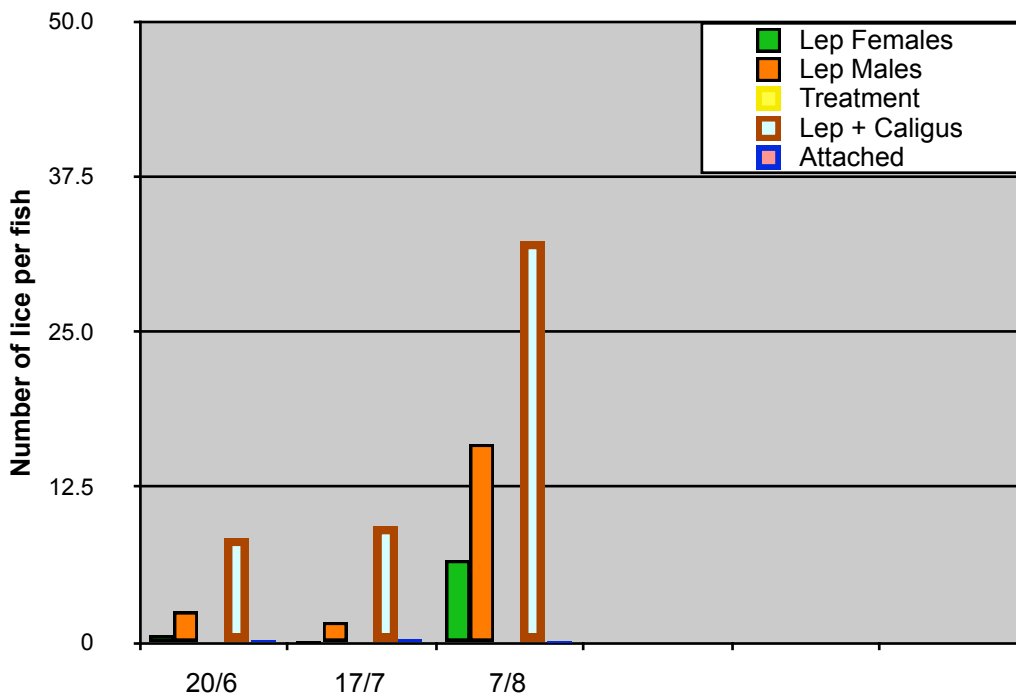
**Golam/Cuigeal\_Cage A3**



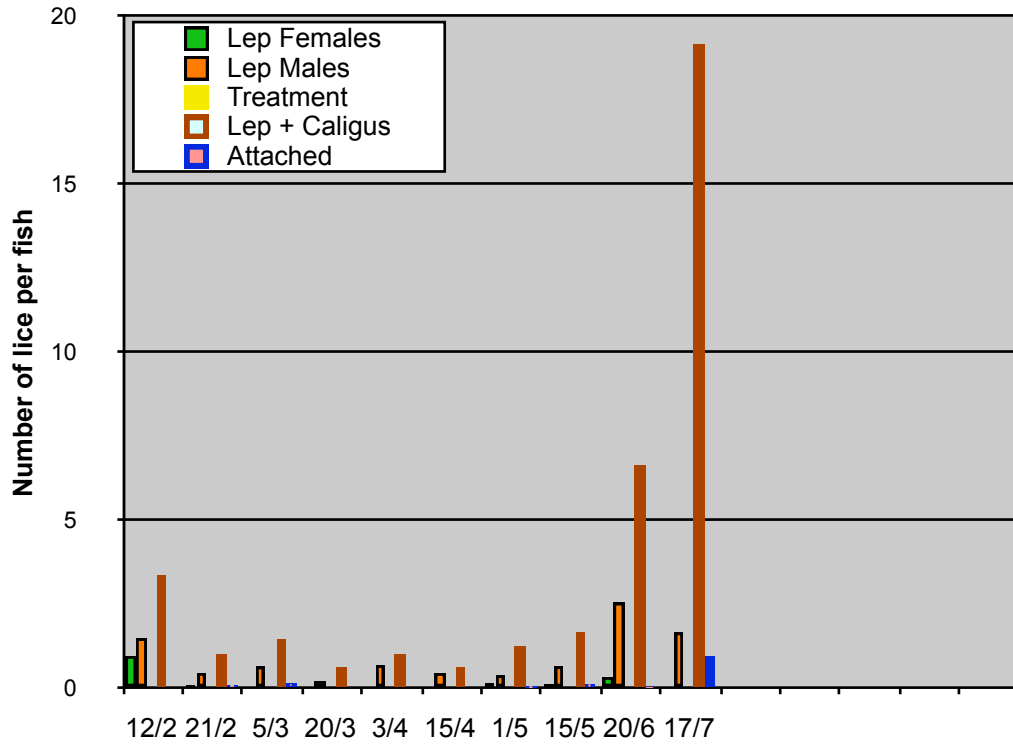

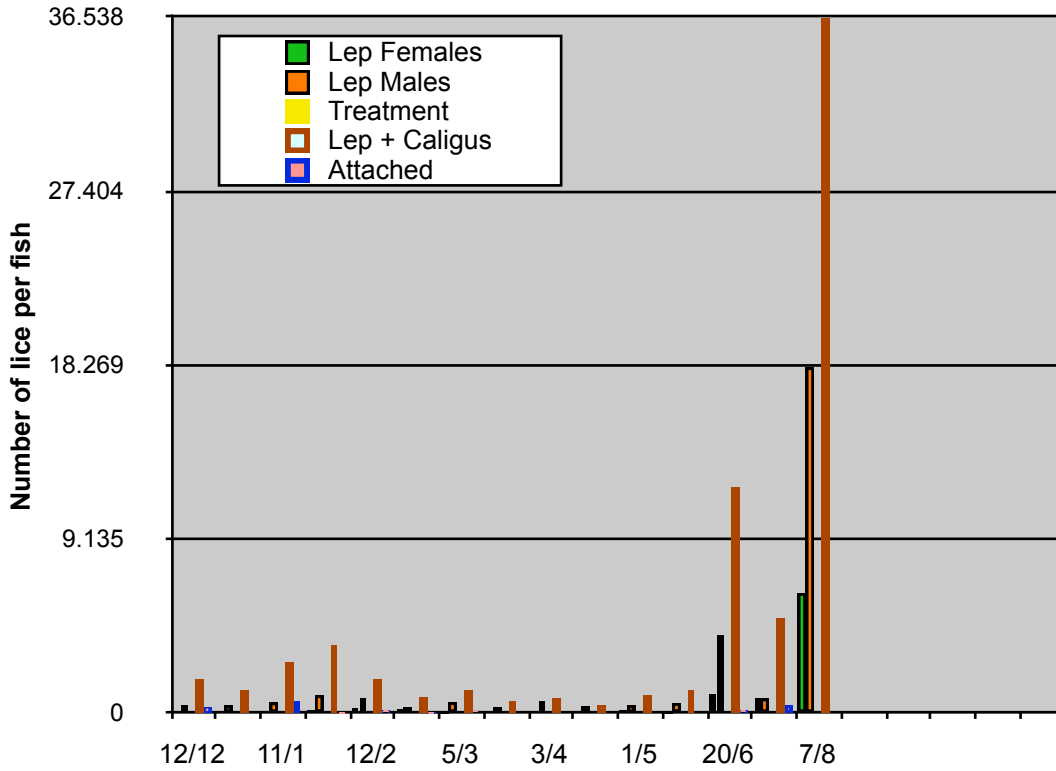

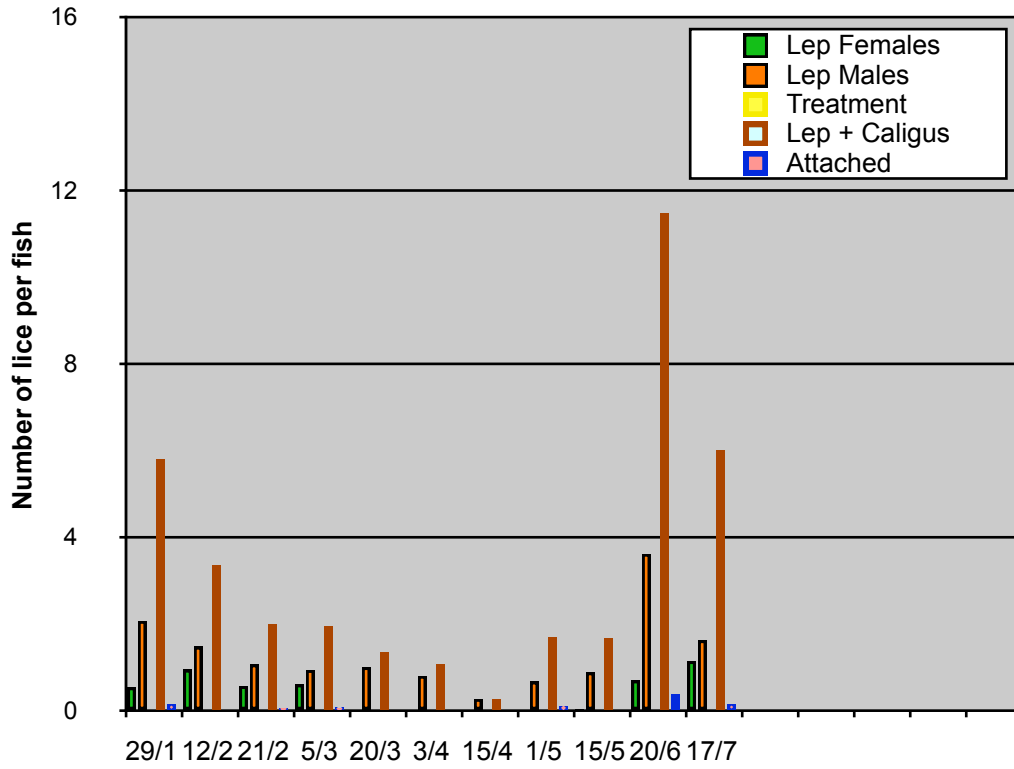
